Who Can Vote?

Anyone who is registered to vote in Texas.

When Can I Vote?

Early Voting: Mon., Oct. 20 – Friday, Oct. 31

Voters can vote at any Early Voting location in the county in which they reside.

Election Day: Tues., Nov. 4, 7 am – 7 pm

Voters must vote in the voting precinct in which they reside.
